Technology is evolving rapidly, and new federal requirements mandate AI integration across K-12 schools. The question isn't whether students will use AI, it's how we ensure AI makes them think more, not less.</p> <p>Through hands-on sessions spanning PYP through DP/CP, participants will explore authentic task design, ethical frameworks, assessment strategies, workflow integration, and evaluative literacy.
